There is no doubt that he planted the seed of the baptist faith in this soil. As as evidence of the character of his teaching and of the influence it exerted, it is said that when he resigned his pastorate at Plymouth, a number of the church opposed his leaving, but Elder Brewster prevailed with the church to grant his request, fearing he said that he would run the same course of rigid separation and Anabaptistry, which Mr. John Smith at Amsterdam had done, who, it appears, was at first a Brownist or Separatist, but afterwards was instrumental in gathering the First Baptist Church in Holland, of which he became pastor. It is apparent therefore that the germinal principle of the baptist faith took root in Plymouth in the very beginning of our history. Though remaining latent for a long period, it no...
