

The bottom can now be removed and the draw pieces drawn out through the side, forming the mold for the intermediate crowns 11, Fig. 272. The sides can now be taken from the core, which appears as in Fig. 282. Bottom Core. The core box for the bottom core is shown in Fig. 283, and the core in Fig. 284, and in the radial section of the assembled cores, Fig....
